NOTICE OF RACE

Fremantle Sailing Club invites you to participate in the 2018 Club Marine Sail Freo

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 including the Australian Sailing Prescriptions and Special Regulations Part 2.
- 1.2. Arbitration will be conducted in accordance with Appendix T.

2. ADVERTISING: [DP]

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1. The regatta is open to Optimist Silver, Optimist Gold, Open Bic Silvers, Open Bic, 420, 470, 505, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Standard, Flying Ant, 29er, 49er, 49er FX, Contender, Musto Skiff, Hobie 16, F18, SB20, Flying Fifteen, Sharpie, Viper and Kite Foiler.
- 3.2. Classes which are not invited by NOR 3.1 above are encouraged to contact the Organising Authority and detail a proposal to attend the event with fleet numbers of six or more entries. Invitation to additional classes may be issued at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 3.3. Eligibility for the Laser Masters and Grand Masters shall be the competitor's age as of Sat 27 October 2018. Masters age group is 45 to 54. Grand Masters age group is 55 to 64.
- 3.4. Competitors must be financial members of a yacht or sailing club that is affiliated with a National Authority recognised by World Sailing.
- 3.5. No substitute competitors will be allowed unless written approval is obtained from the Race Committee.

Entries close at 0900 on Wednesday 24th October 2018.

For competitors entered by **0900 on Monday 15th October 2018** a T-shirt is provided. For those entered after this date a T-Shirt may not be available.

4. FEES:

Regatta Entry:

\$60 per single person boat

\$90 per two person boat

\$120 per three+ person boat

Entries received after entries close may be accepted however may be charged a late fee of \$20.00

5.2. No warning signal will be made after 1500 on the last day of racing.

Please note: Sailors will not be coming in for a lunchbreak during the day. Sailors will need to supply their own lunches and these will need to be given to support/coach boats for handing out on water.

5.3. Races

It is intended to complete up to 8 races.

The maximum number of races per day is four.

Laser Masters will compete in the first 3 races of each day.

6. MEASUREMENT:

All boats shall have a current measurement certificate and are expected to have had their equipment approved by an appropriate measurer prior to this regatta.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website prior to the event.

8. REGATTA SITE:

The regatta will be conducted from the Fremantle Sailing Club Dinghy/Junior Clubhouse.

9. RACING AREA:

The races will be conducted on the area of water adjacent to Success Harbour Fremantle Sailing Club.

The Race Committee intend to conduct racing on three separate race areas. Alternative arrangements may be made under discretion of the Race Committee.

10. COURSES:

The courses will be mainly trapezoid and windward/leeward/triangle as described in the Sailing Instructions.

11. SCORING:

The low-point scoring system, of RRS Appendix A.4.1 will apply.

11.1. To constitute a series 3 races are required to be completed.

11.2. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.3. When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.4. When 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. SUPPORT BOATS [DP]

12.1. Team Managers, Coaches and other support personnel shall register by completing an online registration form available on the event website.

12.2. Approved Support Boats shall keep at least 100m clear of the course area during racing, except when asked to assist by an official from the race committee.

12.3. All Support boats will be marked with a numbered flag available at registration upon the completion of the Support Boat online registration form.

12.4. Support boat skippers will hold a current Recreational Skippers Ticket (valid in Western Australia at the time of the event) and have the applicable safety gear (including a serrated knife) and VHF Radio on board their vessel. VHF radio shall be on at all times whilst on course area. Skipper and Crew are required to wear an appropriate PFD at all times whilst afloat.

12.5. Support personnel and boats shall make themselves available at all times whilst afloat to assist the race committee in the case of an emergency or rescue, as directed in person by a race officer or via VHF Radio.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION: [DP]

13.1. While racing, a boat shall not carry equipment capable of making radio transmissions or receiving radio transmissions except for equipment provided by the Organizing Authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to:

- The first three boats in each fleet with 6 or more boats
- The first two boats in each fleet of 4-5 boats
- The first boat in each fleet with 3 boats or less

Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Committee. Fleets shall be organised and raced at the discretion of the Race Committee.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

15.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15.2. None of the Organising Authority, their officers, members, volunteers, servants or agents accept any responsibility whatsoever in respect of loss of life, personal injury or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in this event or howsoever arising in connection with the event.

16. WARNING:

Sailing and activities associated with it involve risks of personal injury, loss, damage and even death. The risks include but are not limited to, the risk of injury from collision, capsizing, falling overboard, being trapped under the sail or boat after capsize and impact with equipment. Any of these events can also result in death.

The risks involved in this activity are heightened by:

- Adverse weather conditions
- Inadequate training
- Fatigue
- Inexperience
- Failure to maintain the boat
- Failure to supply and use the recommended safety equipment
- Failure to observe the RRS and the FSC Sailing Instructions

This warning is given as a risk warning pursuant to Section 51 of the Civil Liability Act 2002 (as amended). Having given this risk warning, Fremantle Sailing Club will not be held liable for any personal injury or death, however it may occur.

17. INSURANCE:

- 17.1. All boats competing in the 2018 Club Marine Sail Freo shall have current for the duration of the event third party insurance cover of not less than AUD \$10,000,000 or equivalent in any other currency.
- 17.2. All competitors who submit the entry form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.
- 17.3. Competitors may be required to provide details and evidence that they have such insurance in place at the time of entry or registration.

18. MEDIA RIGHTS:

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
